WHAT IS ISO 27001?

ISO 27001 is the international standard for Information which provides the requirements for **establishing, implementing, maintaining and improving Information Security Management Systems (ISMS)**. It requires procedures for: Risk Management, Monitoring, measurement, analysis, and evaluation, and Improvement.



WHO NEEDS ISO 27001?

Businesses who are expanding internationally and are aiming to show they **protect information confidentiality, integrity, and availability through risk management** can benefit from **ISO 27001**.



WHY IS ISO 27001 IMPORTANT?

ISO 27001 provides a **structured approach to implementing and improving ISMS**. It helps protect assets from threats by:

- Understanding organisational needs, requirements, and risk appetite.
- Applying policies, procedures, and controls to manage risks within the organisation's tolerance levels.
- Continuously monitoring performance against standards.
